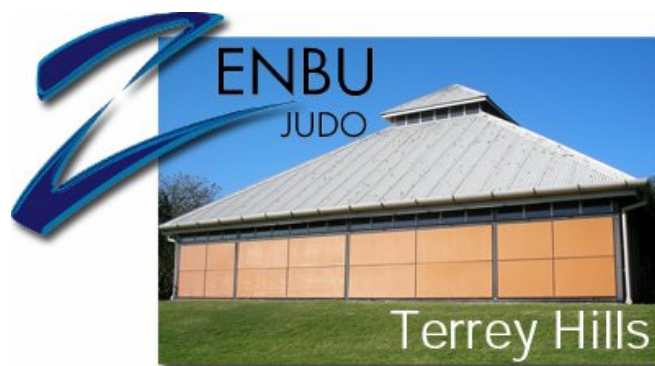

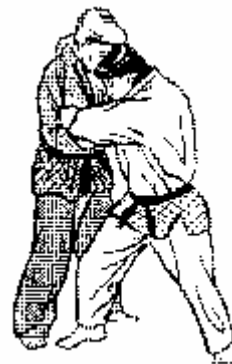

U16 Boys

No one came close to Jin Kim from Zenbu taking out all of his competition with the 3 big ippon throws including 2 great Tai-o-toshi techniques.

Under 13 and under 10

Vincent Salinos got a silver medal winning 2 out of 3 matches u34kgs

Jonathan Holland also took silver winning 4 out of 7 u46kgs.

Kieran won 2 silvers in the two heaviest divisions u60 & u66kgs; he won 4 out of 7.

Junior Grading – 9th November

Requirements for under 13 and under 10 years only

All grades need to show proper Ukemi (breakfalls) and a knowledge of theory increasing with grade

Yellow – 2 throws, 2 holds, 1 escape, 1 turnover

Orange – 4 throws, 3 holds, 2 escape, 2 turnover

Green – 6 throws, 4 holds, 3 escape, 2 turnover

Blue – 8 throws, 5 holds, 4 escape, 3 turnover
